**GENERAL LICENCE FOR INTRA-EU TRANSFER OF MILITARY EQUIPMENT TO
THE ARMED FORCES OF OTHER MEMBER STATES (BSL LT 01)**

(set forth in paragraph 5.1 of the Licensing Rules for Export, Import, Transit, Brokering and Intra-EU Transfer of Strategic Goods approved by Resolution No 932 of the Government of the Republic of Lithuania of 22 July 2004 (Official Gazette 2004, No [115-4305](#); 2012, No [64-3229](#))

Licence issue authority – the Ministry of Economy.

1. Military equipment

The following categories of military equipment covered under the Common Military List, approved by Order No V-1216 of the Minister of National Defence of the Republic of Lithuania of 29 December 2009, shall be subject to the General Licence for Intra-EU Transfer of Military Equipment to the Armed Forces of other Member States (BSL LT 01) (hereinafter referred to as „General Licence for Transfer of Military Equipment BSL LT 01”) (Official Gazette 2010, No [6-248](#); 2011, No [92-4400](#)):

2. Destinations

The General Licence for Transfer of Military Equipment BSL LT 01 shall be valid for transfers to the Member States of the European Union.

3. Conditions and requirements for the use of the licence

3.1. To transfer military equipment, covered under paragraph 1 of the General Licence for Transfer of Military Equipment BSL LT 01, to the armed forces of other EU Member States the military equipment supplier shall comply with the requirements laid down in:

3.1.1. Article 11 (1) and Article 13 (1) and (2) of the Law on the Control of Strategic Goods of the Republic of Lithuania (Official Gazette 1995, No [61-1533](#); 2011, No [128-6052](#));

3.1.2. Paragraph 55 and paragraph 58 of the Licensing Rules for Export, Import, Transit, Brokering and Intra-EU Transfer of Strategic Goods.

4. Suspending the licence, lifting suspension of the licence and revoking the licence

4.1. In the cases specified in Article 10 (2) of the Law on the Control of Strategic Goods of the Republic of Lithuania, the General Licence for Transfer of Military Equipment BLS LT 01 shall be suspended for a particular military equipment supplier;

4.2. In the cases specified in Article 10 (3) of the Law on the Control of Strategic Goods of the Republic of Lithuania, the suspension of the General Licence for Transfer of Military Equipment BLS LT 01 shall be lifted for a particular military equipment supplier;

4.3. In the cases specified in Article 10 (4) of the Law on the Control of Strategic Goods of the Republic of Lithuania, the General Licence for Transfer of Military Equipment BLS LT 01 shall be revoked for a particular military equipment supplier.

GENERAL LICENCE FOR INTRA-EU TRANSFER OF MILITARY EQUIPMENT TO CERTIFIED UNDERTAKINGS IN OTHER MEMBER STATES (BSL LT 02)

(set forth in paragraph 5.2 of the Licensing Rules for Export, Import, Transit, Brokering and Intra-EU Transfer of Strategic Goods approved by Resolution No 932 of the Government of the Republic of Lithuania of 22 July 2004 (Official Gazette 2004, No [115-4305](#); 2012, No [64-3229](#))

Licence issue authority – the Ministry of Economy.

1. Military equipment

The military equipment supplier, who wants to transfer to the certified undertakings of other EU Member States the components, parts, systems and sub-systems of military equipment referred to in paragraph 1 of the General Licence for Transfer of Military Equipment BLS LT 02, shall comply with the following requirements laid down in:

3.1.1. Article 11 (1) and Article 13 (1) and (2) of the Law on the Control of Strategic Goods of the Republic of Lithuania (Official Gazette 1995, No [61-1533](#); 2011, No [128-6052](#));

3.1.2. Paragraph 55 and paragraph 58 of the Licensing Rules for Export, Import, Transit, Brokering and Intra-EU Transfer of Strategic Goods.

4. Suspending the licence, lifting suspension of the licence and revoking the licence

3. Conditions and requirements for the use of the licence

3.1. The military equipment supplier who wants to transfer, for the maintenance or repair purposes, the military equipment referred to in paragraph 1 of the General Licence for Transfer of Military Equipment BLS LT 04 to the recipient of the military equipment, who is the original supplier or producer of the military equipment and who is situated in another EU Member State, shall comply with the following requirements laid down in:

3.1.1. Article 11 (1) and Article 13 (1) and (2) of the Law on the Control of Strategic Goods of the Republic of Lithuania (Official Gazette 1995, No [61-1533](#); 2011, No [128-6052](#));

3.1.2. Paragraph 55 and paragraph 58 of the Licensing Rules for Export, Import, Transit, Brokering and Intra-EU Transfer of Strategic Goods.

3.2. The military equipment supplier shall ensure that the military equipment transferred for the maintenance or repair purposes is returned.

4. Suspending the licence, lifting suspension of the licence and revoking the licence
